- Day of event registration opens at 9:30 am
- Registration is located at the start/finish at 836 Erie Street E, look for the big sign that says 'REGISTRATION'
- Registration closes 30 minutes before all races
- U15 and Novice race is for first year and young racers. Ability based, open to all ages and genders - it is intended as an introductory event. All racers are required to hold a Provincial Race license or a UCI Race License
- Junior aged riders looking to upgrade to Elite 2 Men or Elite 2 Women categories must submit an upgrade request using the appropriate youth/junior upgrade request form
- Ontario Junior (U19) men and women shall race the category on their license (E4 or E3)
- Riders may only enter one race category and are not permitted to race in multiple categories
- The first lap of all races is neutral, for safety and course familiarization
- U17 and U19: \$20 registration fees

Refund Note: Any pre-event refund request will be considered on a case by case basis. Registration fees will be refunded if the race gets cancelled.

## COURSE LAYOUT

The course is completely flat with four corners ( 4 right turns) and a lap distance of approximately 1.8 km (the first corner is a traffic circle). The course will be closed for all races. The start/finish line is located on Erie St. E between Marentette Ave. and Elsmere Ave. From the start line the course direction is clockwise in the order of Erie, Parent, Giles, and then Howard. The wheel pit is located at the intersection of Marentette Ave. and Erie St. E.

## NEAREST HOSPITAL

The closest hospital to the course is Windsor Regional Hospital - Ouellette Campus located at the corner of Erie St. and Ouellette Ave. It is 0.5 km West of the race course. The Emergency entrance to the hospital is on Goyeau St. between Erie St. and Giles Blvd.

## Directions to the Race

- From Highway 401 westbound... exit 13 towards the tunnel to USA, continue on to Dougall Ave. which turns into Ouellette Place, turn right onto Erie St.
- From Ambassador Bridge... take first right immediately after customs booths onto Huron Church northbound, turn right at first light - Wyandotte St., turn right at Ouellette, turn left at Erie St.
- From Detroit Windsor Tunnel... turn left onto Park St., turn left at Ouellette, turn left at Erie St.

## Parking

There is plenty of parking available in nearby municipal parking lots and on side streets where there are no restrictions.

## EVENT RULES

- The race will be held under the current rules of the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI), Canadian Cycling (CC) and Ontario Cycling (OC).
- Registration closes 30 minutes before each race.
- Registration is located at 836 Erie St. E.
- Online registration is available and closes Wednesday, August 9th at midnight.
- All riders holding either a Ontario Provincial Licence or a UCI Licence will be eligible to race.
- ALL RIDERS MUST SIGN IN AT REGISTRATION.
- Licensed Commissaires will be officiating.
- Only official TDVI vehicles are allowed on the course.
- All team and vendor tents must be approved by TDVI prior to the event without exceptions!
- No feeding/handing water bottles to the racers during the races.
- Any rider dropping out of the race shall immediately notify a Commissaire.
- Riders may be pulled from the race by the Commissaire's at their discretion.
- Free laps for punctures, recognized mishaps, or breakage of an essential part of the bicycle will be allowed subject to Commissaire's discretion.
- NO free laps will be granted during the last 5 laps of the race.
- The Wheel pit will be located at Marentette and Erie. All wheels must be marked with the team name and racer number.
- Groups being overtaken should stay to the right hand side of the course.
- Award presentation will take place after every race.
- Top 5 finishers are required to attend the presentation and are expected to wear their competition uniform for photos.
- NO WARM-UPS on the course. Use Giles Blvd. on the North Side OR streets in the nearby area.
- CAUTION: Open to traffic!
- Any inquiries on race day should be directed to the registration office or start/finish staff.


## NUMBER PLACEMENT

- Numbers must be placed on the right hip and lower right back. Your number must be visible to the camera, on the right side of the road. No altering of the race numbers is allowed.


## EQUIPMENT RULES

- UCI/CC/OC rules apply and can be found online.
- Traditional wheels or approved non-traditional wheels only.

- Standard handlebars only.
- NO sleeveless jerseys will be permitted.
- Helmets must be worn by ALL registered racers at ALL times in and around the race venue.
- Gear restrictions will be enforced for U17 categories. Juniors and upgraded U17 cadets racing in Elite categories will not be subjected to gear restrictions.
- Radios are not permitted in any category.

- U17 prizes are awarded as gift cards.
