GENERAL INFORMATION

Ontario Cycling (OC) is proud to present the 2023 Road Ontario Cup (OCup) Series. The Road OCup Series, sanctioned and governed by Ontario Cycling, consists of 3 separate racing opportunities, at unique locations across the province. The OC OCup Series is designed to provide high-quality racing opportunities for riders prior to competing at the Provincial Championships.

OCUP #1 - HENDERSON CLASSIC ROAD RACE

Located just 25 minutes from Hwy 400/401, this brand-new course features a 12 km loop of smooth county and rural roads with approximately 90 meters of elevation each lap. Racers will start and finish out of the newly built Henderson Memorial Park, located just off of Line 9, north/west of Bradford West Gwillimbury.

OCUP #2 - NORTHUMBERLAND CLASSIC ROAD RACE

Returning for 2023, the Northumberland Classic Road Race will feature some of the best roads in the county. The loop itself is 15.2km in length, featuring 194m in elevation and an 8.5km out and back section from the start/finish which is out of the Baltimore Recreation Complex. Athletes will race by picturesque areas of Northumberland including St. Ann's Spa and renowned equestrian facilities. Racers will also have full access to the recreation complex including indoor washrooms and change-room facilities.

OCUP #3 - LANSDOWNE CLASSIC ROAD RACE

New for 2023, the Lansdowne Road Race is a lollipop style course located 30 minutes east of Kingston Ontario. The 14km loop features only 20m in elevation with a 4km out and back section from the start/finish at the Thousand Islands Elementary School. This is by far the flattest road racecourse of the year, so we encourage all of Ontario's top sprinters to attend!

2023 ONTARIO CYCLING ROAD PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

INDIVIDUAL TIME TRIAL PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

New for 2023, the Individual Time Trial Championships will be incorporated into the Road Provincial Championships. The Municipality of East Ferris (20km south of North Bay) will be the host for this event and will share some of the same roads used for the Provincial Road Race. Riders will start in the Town of Corbeil ON, heading south along Corbeil Road for roughly 11km. The course would be considered relatively challenging, as it features over 100 meters of climbing for every 10km of racing. Riders will turn around at the Wasi Cross Country Ski Club, making their way back along the same stretch of roadway they came out on.

CRITERIUM PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

The City of North Bay will once again be the host of the 2023 Provincial Criterium Championships! Located by the North Bay Airport, the circuit is roughly 1km in length with almost 10 meters of elevation per lap. There is a mix of sweeping and technical turns throughout the course.

ROAD RACE PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Municipality of East Ferris (20km south of North Bay) will once again be the host venue for the 2023 Road Provincial Championships! The race will feature a neutral rollout to start, leaving from the East Ferris Municipal Office. Once riders make their way onto the course, they will compete on a 15km circuit, featuring rolling hills with roughly 150 meters of elevation per lap. The finish is located on Champaign Rd, right beside the KRMP Wellness Studio. The Ontario Provincial Police will be on hand to ensure rider safety.

REGISTRATION & PRICING

ONTARIO CUP REGISTRATION

- Registration for all Road OCups is open to Ontario Cycling licensed riders 15 years of age and older.
- The event is pre-registration only. No day of registration will be accepted.
- Only Provincial Race Licenses and UCI Race Licenses are permitted. Out-of-Province riders must have a UCI License. Licenses will not be sold on event day and must be purchased in advance.
- New this year, there will be 2 types of registrations for our OCups:
 - o **A) Series Registration** includes OCups 1, 2, 3
 - o B) Individual Registration one of OCup 1, 2, or 3
- Registration for each OCup will close on the **Tuesday at 12:00pm noon** of event week.
- If the Tuesday at 12:00pm noon registration deadline passes and a rider would still like to register, they have until Wednesday at 5:00pm to contact the OC office for registration to be re-opened and will be charged a \$50 late entry fee.
- Please note that the OCup Series Registration does not include Provincial Championships. Registration for Provincials will be through a separate registration.

PROVINCIAL REGISTRATION

- Registration for Provincial Championships will close on the **Tuesday at** 12:00pm noon of event week.
- If the Tuesday at 12:00pm noon registration deadline passes and a rider would still like to register, they have until Wednesday at 5:00pm to contact the OC office for registration to be re-opened and are charged a \$50 late entry fee.
- Registration for Provincial Championships will close on the **Tuesday at** 12:00pm noon of event week.

New for 2023

- To participate at the 2023 Ontario Road Provincial Championships, an Ontario athlete must have participated in at least 1 Road Ontario Cup (either 1, 2, or 3).
- Exemptions:
 - Para-athletes racing the Individual Time Trial or Criterium at the 2023
 Ontario Road Provincial Championships.
 - Individuals registering for the Individual Time Trial event at the 2023
 Ontario Road Provincial Championships.
 - Individuals registering for the 2023 Provincial Criterium are required to race at either 1 Road Ontario Cup (either 1, 2 or 3) or a Regional Criterium event.

If for sufficient reason a rider cannot compete at a Road OCup and would like to participate at Road Provincials, they can request an exemption by completing the google form linked here.

Please note that you must register in the specific category as stated on your 2023 license, you may be moved to a different category if selected incorrectly upon registering. You will be notified via email of this change.

REFUND/TRANSFER POLICY

- Refunds will not be given.
- Transfers from one individual to another or transfers from one event to another is not permitted.
- OC reserves the right to issue refunds for exceptional cases. Reasons such as injury, loss/change of employment, or relocation such that the participant can no longer attend, will be considered.

EVENT CATEGORIES & DISTANCES

OCup categories are an open ability-based format where athletes will be placed in the category that appears on their license. The ability-based component of categories is designed to provide meaningful competition for all riders and help ensure appropriate participant numbers for quality racing.

Provincial categories are age based where athletes race in categories based on their age as of December 31st 2023. The age-based categories are designed to allow riders to race against those within the same age category.

<u>Eddy Merckx Category:</u> (non-Aero) riders are not permitted to use any aero equipment including aerobars, clip-on bars, disc wheels, shoe covers or aero helmets. Bicycles must meet the requirements of mass start races including wheels.

New for 2023 Riders will earn a x1.2 multiplier to their total 2023 OCup Points tally for having competed in the 2023 Provincial Championships of the respective discipline. To earn the multiplier a rider must both register for Provincial Championships and start their race, riders who do not start their race (DNS) are not eligible. For example, the final top three of an OCup category could look like:

CATEGORY UPGRADE PROCESS

New for 2023

New for 2023, upgrade criteria will be used in place of points to determine if a rider is eligible to upgrade categories. With mandatory upgrade category criteria that is easier to achieve, the new upgrade process will provide greater flexibility for optional movement between categories, while protecting categories against strong riders. Riders will be eligible to earn criteria to upgrade at OCups of the respective discipline they are looking to upgrade in.

E4 to E3 M3 to M2	Win 2 OCups, Place 3 times on the podium at OCups, Elite 1/2 CX Status, Elite MTB Status, or Junior Expert MTB Status	Self-Selection (all riders have the option to self-seed as E4 or E3 and M3 or M2 in accordance with their age category)

** You must race the category on your license, please notify the Ontario Cycling office in advance of your event if you are planning to upgrade or downgrade categories. You may be asked to provide additional information such as race results upon submitting a request to upgrade or downgrade.







AWARDS

- Medals will be awarded to the top three (3) finishers in each category.
- Should categories be combined because of low participation numbers, results will be broken out for awards. Awards will be awarded based on the results of each category separated.
- Riders must attend the awards ceremonies or risk forfeiting their awards.
- Podium protocol shall be enforced, and fines issued to those who fail to comply. Riders must wear their competition uniform for medal presentations. Hats and/or eyewear are prohibited.
- Medal presentations will take place following the conclusion of each race.
