Some important notes:

- 3-4 Person Team Age Sub-Category The age sub-category is the combined age of 4 riders. If you have 3 riders, you must add the age of an imaginary 4th rider that is the average age of the 3 real riders. Make sure you are in the correct age sub-category! You can update riders and categories any time up to the race.
- Pit Area Set Up There are no designated pit sites for this race (except for Solo Areas). There will be room at the race site for teams to place a tent and gear beside their vehicles. Please take only the space you really need to allow everyone appropriate space!
- Solo Riders have dedicated area along the course. See site plan for map to access Solo area and follow the red **Bontrager** banners. There is space for one car and a tent for each solo rider only. This is for Solo riders only, please respect their needs.
- Parking Crew and Marshall Crews The Hardwood Ski Team and their parents are helping to make the parking process easy and smooth, and to help with clean up. The Ski Team will be asking for donations to help with waxing and travel expenses for these young athletes. Please also help the parking crew by keeping your area clean and taking recycling home!
- Live Timing System We are using Zone 4 GO chips for timing. The chip is your teams Baton. See https://zone4.ca/event/2023/6a4NR0/ for live timing on your mobile device.
- **Food Service** Cravings is open all day for food and drink at the Food Trailer. They are also offering a special post-race Meal and Beer Special of 2 Epic Smash Burger Tacos (as seen on TikTok) for \$16.00 and a Beer for only \$6.50.
