Ontario Cycling (OC) and Milton BMX is proud to present the 2025 BMX (UCI) Provincial Championships which will be held on September 21st, 2025. The BMX (UCI) Provincial Championships is sanctioned and governed by Ontario Cycling.

Ontario Cycling BMX Provincial Championships is separate from the BMX USA Provincial Race Series. OC BMX Provincial Championships will follow UCI rules for this event and will also be a qualifier for the 2026 World Championships in Brisbane, Australia.

Registration & Pricing

- Registration for BMX Provincials is open to Ontario Riders only aged 5+

- The event is pre-registration only. Only 2025 Challenge/Compete/UCI licenses are permitted. Non-member permits are available for riders who are not members of Ontario Cycling. Licenses will not be sold on event day and must be purchased in advanced
- Registration for BMX provincials closes on the Wednesday prior to the event date
- Late entries will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis if granted there will be an additional \$50 late fee applied.

Refund Policy

- A rider must withdraw prior to the registration closing to be eligible to receive a refund. Once the registration period has ended; refunds are no longer available.
- All refunds are subject to a non-refundable processing fee (variable based on transaction value) plus CCN refund administration fee.
- OC reserves the right to issue refunds in other race and exceptional cases. Injury, loss/change of employment, or a move away from the town such that the participant can no longer attend, will not be considered.

Event Categories

- BMX (UCI) Provincial Championship categories will be aged-based format where athletes will have to race their national age listed on their license

- Categories may be combined based on the number of entries or at the discretion of OC.

Start List & Results

- Results and the motos will be posted on site on the moto board
- Results will be posted on the Ontario Cycling website under the results section at the conclusion of the event.
- Results will be determined by the finish judges.

Event Rules

Technical Rules

- UCI Regulations with OC specific event rules will be enforced for all categories

Ontario Provincial Championships Specific Rules

- Gate Selection for Championships (Elite, U23, Junior) classes will be determined by current UCI ranking, then by random draw. Gate selection for all Challenge classes will be determined by Random Draw.
- For Ontario Provincial Championships, all riders 12 and under will not be allowed to use clipless pedals. In the event that riders 12 and under race in a combined class, the use of clipless pedals to the rider's age division must be maintained.
- Full face helmets must be securely fastened.
- Full finger gloves must be worn whenever the athlete is on the track.
- Jerseys with numbers on the back will be allowed for this event.

General Event Rules

- Championship Men (Junior/U23/Elite) must take the pro section

Rider Confirmation

- Rider confirmation will begin at 7:30am and will close 30 minutes before the start of the first race.
- Rider confirmation will take place at the registration hut

Plates

- BMX Canada plates should be used for BMX Provincials
- Plates must be on the bike when an athlete is on the track including during practice
- All riders are required to have both a plastic plate and a side plate
- The plate color rule will not be enforced

Awards

- Medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in all 20-inch challenge, 24-inch cruiser, and 20-inch championship categories, regardless of the number of riders present.
- A provincial jersey will be awarded to the Provincial Champion in each of the 20-inch championship categories (Junior, U23, Elite)
- Should categories be combined due to low participation numbers, results will be broken out for awards. Awards will be awarded based on the results of each class separated
- Riders must attend the awards ceremonies or risk forfeiting their awards
- Podium protocol shall be enforced, and fines be issued to those who fail to comply. Riders must wear their competition uniform for medal presentations. Hats and/or eyewear are prohibited.
- All medal presentations will take place at the end of the event.

Event Safety

- First aid will be provided by Odyssey Medical who will be under a tent near the 3rd corner
- For your safety, if you withdraw from the event for any reason, you must inform the nearest Commissaire that you will no longer be racing. Riders not reporting to the Commissaire may be subject to a fine.
- Riders must wear an approved, regulation cycling helmet while riding their bike within the track fenced area.
- Should a Commissaire or OC representative feel that a rider is unfit to race for any reason, the OC reserves the right to remove the rider from the event for their own safety and the safety of others.

Media


- Anyone wanting to create media content with professional equipment or to sell content must obtain accreditation from Ontario Cycling.

- There will be available parking on site.




Course Map
