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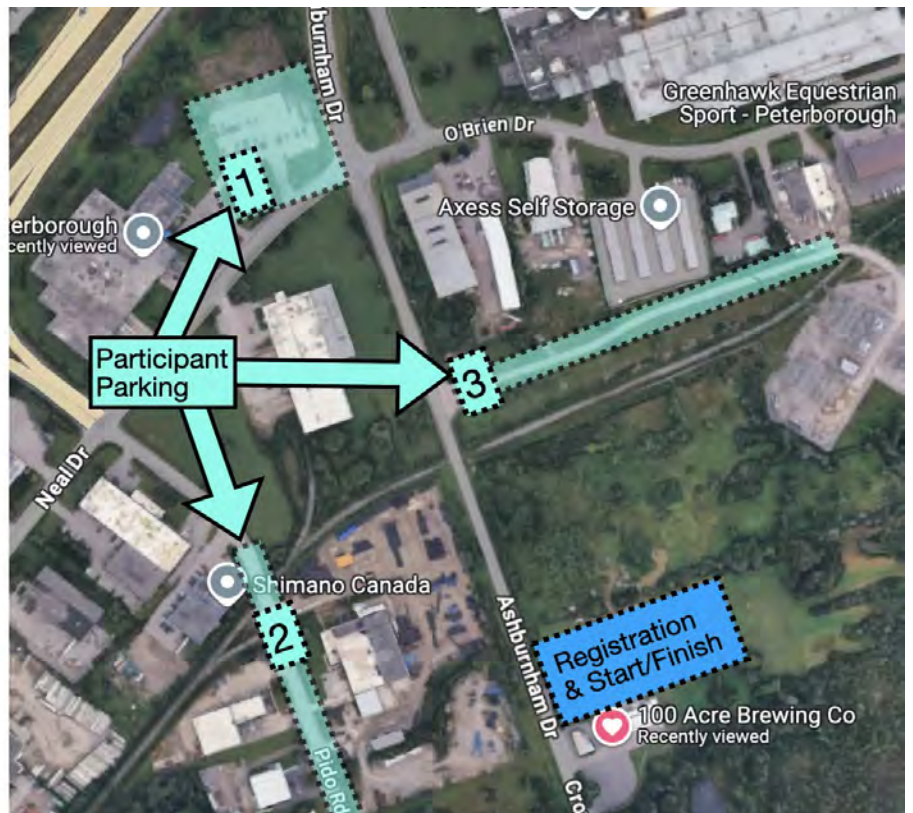

*\*All riders must sign-in before their race. Sign-in closes 30 minutes prior to the start.*

## Event Rules

- All riders must sign-in at registration at least 30 minutes prior to their start.
- Rider staging will begin 15 minutes prior to race start.
- The race is held on OPEN ROADS and riders shall obey HTA laws unless otherwise instructed by OPP or race marshal.
- Riders to obey rules and instructions from OPP and race marshals
- Riders are to yield to traffic at uncontrolled intersections and trail crossings.
- Riders are expected to share the road and trail with other users
- Riders are to ride on the right side of the road where possible
- Any rider dropping out of the race shall immediately notify a marshal, OPP, volunteer, or race organizers.
- There is no neutral service provided. Riders must carry their own equipment to repair flat tires and technical issues.
- In case of lightning, the race may be delayed or cancelled. If you are informed that the race has been stopped due to lightning, you are advised to seek shelter until the race can resume. No refunds will be issued if the race is cancelled. If there are any changes or delays in the schedule.



## Equipment Regulations

- At all times when warming up or participating in the event, riders who are mounted on a bicycle shall wear a helmet at all times.
- Two-way radios are reserved for race organization only.

## Staging & Start Protocol

- Riders will start in a Mass Start Format according to the above schedule.
- Start Corrals to open 15 minutes prior to start. Riders are reminded to follow instructions for maintaining proper distancing.
- Race Officials will start each wave of the race.

## Technical Assistance Regulations

- 1) Mechanical support will be on-site at the start/finish courtesy of Wild Rock
- 2) Riders are responsible to carry their own flat repair tools and equipment
- 3) Riders who are unable to continue the race due to technical issues are required to notify marshals, volunteers, or race organizers. Efforts will be made to pick up a rider and drive them to the start/finish.

## Bad Weather and Course Changes

- Extreme weather may result in cancellation.
- Changes to the course may be required in case of severe weather or changing atmospheric conditions. Changes will be announced at the start of all races. In all conditions riders should ensure they are riding within their limits and dismount if the terrain exceeds their technical comfort level.
- In the case of severe weather requiring a change of schedule, an email will be sent out to all participants, and information will be posted on Social Media



## Emergency & Medical

All individuals are responsible for their own property at all times. Race organizers and the venue staff are not responsible for any lost or stolen items including theft of bicycles or other personal belongings.

**In the event of an emergency, volunteers, participants, and race organizers are to contact 9-1-1 unless otherwise instructed by on-site medical staff personnel and Police Officers.**

### **First Aid & Medical**

Trained medical first responders will be on-site to administer first aid at the start/finish and near registration. During the race, medical staff will be located at the aid station at the Lang Hastings Trail crossing at David Fife Line if they are not responding to an emergency on course.

### **Incident Reporting**

For emergencies and incident reporting, participants are to alert officials and request medical or other support by notifying one of the many race support vehicles, OPP officers, aid station attendees and medical staff, or volunteer race marshal.

### **Medical Services**

Medical staff will be on hand throughout the race and at the start/finish until all riders are off course. First aid and basic medical services will be provided by the on-site staff. Severe injuries will be directed to the nearest emergency medical centre at Peterborough Regional Health Centre, or Campbellford Hospital depending on which part of the race course the incident occurs.

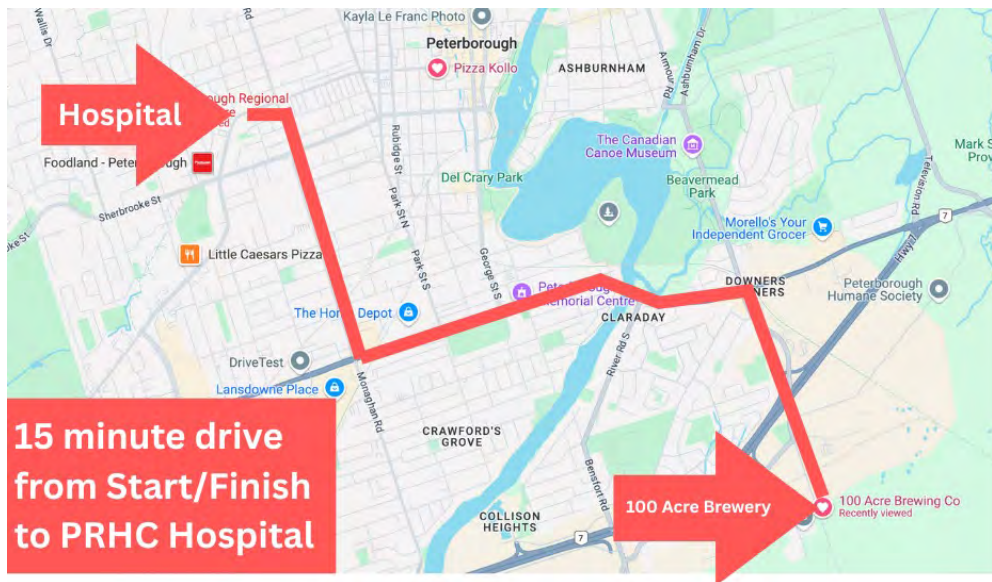

## Hospital Locations

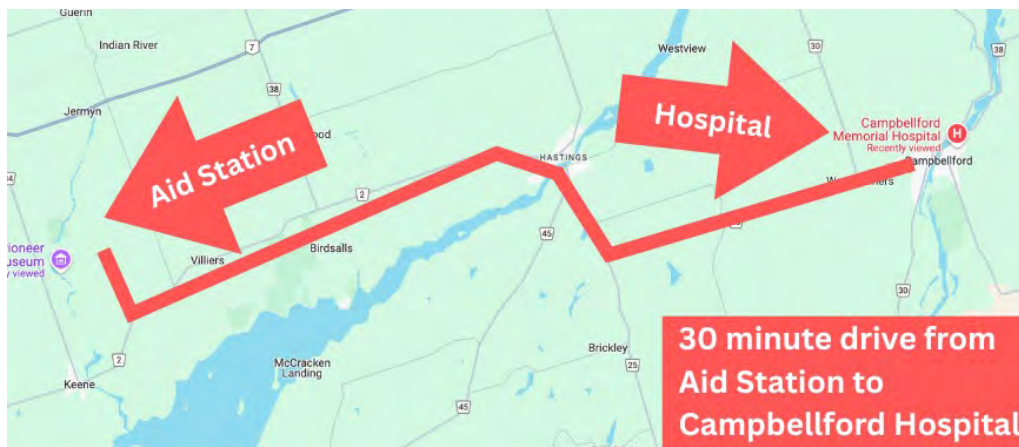
The nearest hospital to the start/finish (100 Acre Brewing Co., 390 Ashburnham Drive) is **Peterborough Regional Health Centre** located at 1 Hospital Drive, Peterborough, ON K9J 7C6 (Phone: 705-743-2121).

To drive from the start/finish, proceed north on Ashburnham Drive towards Lansdowne Avenue, and then head West to Monaghan Road, turning right to go North. At the traffic lights, make a left on Sherbrooke and head west until Hospital Drive, making a right turn. The hospital is located near Sherbrooke Street and Clonsilla Ave.





The nearest hospital to the Eastern portion of the race course (towards Hastings) is the **Campbellford Hospital** located at 46 Oliver Rd, Campbellford, ON K0L 1L0 (Phone: 705 653-1140).

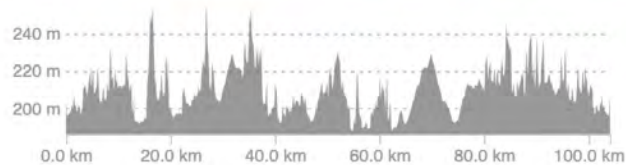
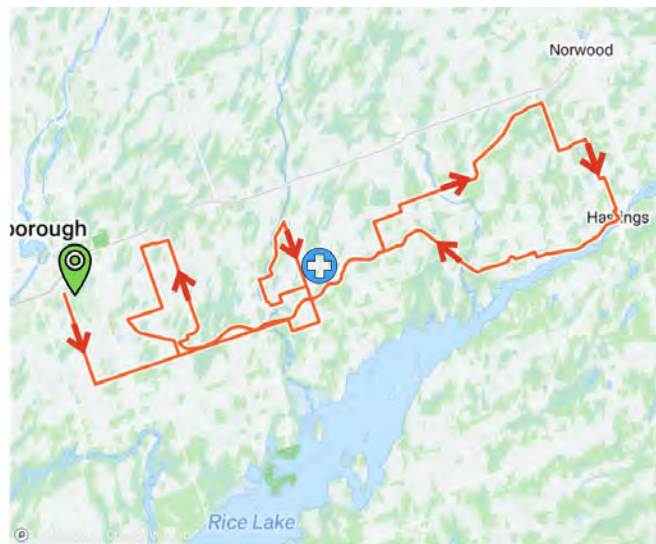
To drive from the Aid Station, head South on David Fife Line to County Rd. 2, and then head East to Hastings, turning south on Bridge Street towards Highway 35, and then East to Campbellford.

- Rest/Aid Station 

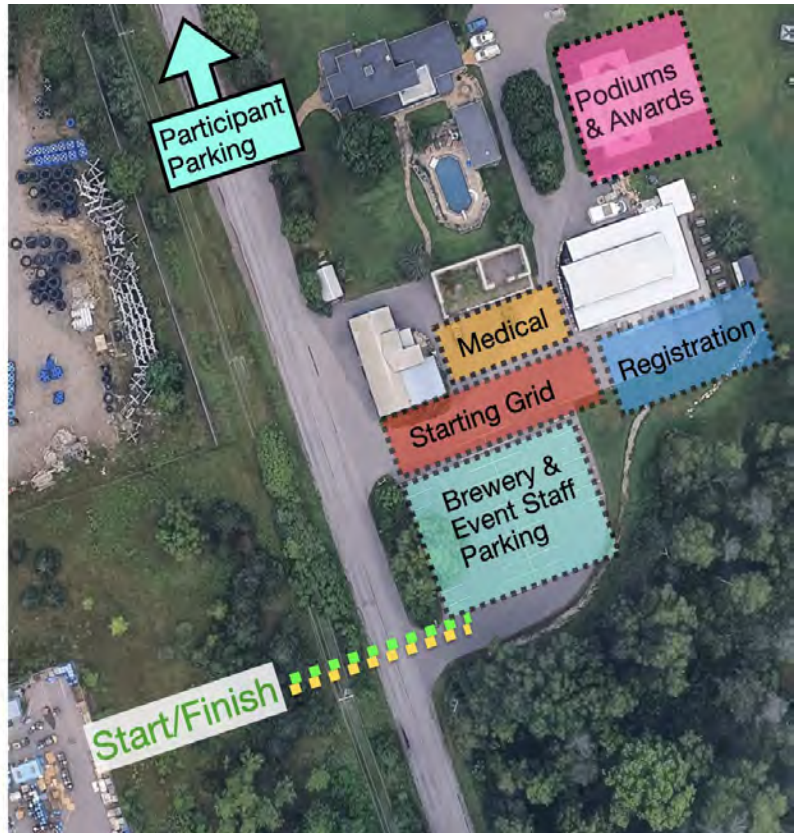

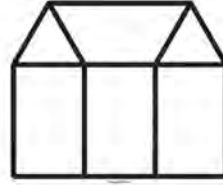
