Summary:

The Mountain Bike Trail and Fleet Technician is to oversee and direct the daily operation of the Mountain Bike department including the Rental Shop. The manager is also tasked with working together with the Director of Sport to plan the direction and programming of the Mountain Bike Department. The role requires an independent individual with strong leadership, and an in depth knowledge of Mountain Bike trends and business as a whole.

- Operate hand tools and small equipment (shovels, rakes, tampers, chainsaws, brush cutters)
- Monitor trail safety and identify potential hazards
- Install and maintain trail signage and safety fencing
- Communicate trail conditions to the Mountain Operations team
- Ensure trails meet bike park safety and design standards
- Develop a range of programs to sell to the local community as well as ways to make mountain biking a great experience for hotel guests.
- Create and foster relationships with local bike stores to work together to promote our offerings
- Be aware of Hockley Valley Resort policies and procedures as they impact your department
- Manage the guest service aspect of bike
- Attend weekly department meetings
